Participation in Relevant Projects

- Two and a half years working in the development and maintenance of a set of iOS libraries integrated in an omnichannel solution for banking.
- Two years and seven months working as part of a team of 50+ engineers maintaining and developing new features for an iOS native eCommerce channel for luxury fashion
- Fifteen months leading a team on the maintenance and development of new features, including the introduction to the project of myself and the whole team, as tech lead and scrum master.
- Eighteen months working on the creation (6 months), maintenance and development of a new betting app, highly regarded in the betting community, and also co-responsible for Continuous Delivery and Deployment.
- Twelve months working on maintenance and new features on a highly rated betting app, and also responsible for Continuous Delivery and Deployment.
- A fourteen month long project (with several phases) developing a set of five apps for a Portuguese Banking Corporation, for both Android and iPhone. Lead developer in iOS app. Technology team

leader for the duration of most of the project, responsible for non-major decisions on user-experience in Android and iPhone. Day-to-day direct interaction with the customer.

- A six month project for a book publisher, developing 5 dictionary apps compatible with both iPhone and iPad using RESTful+XML Web services.
- A month long project working with a top Portuguese broadcasting network, developing the first iPad app in Portugal for a television network. On-site development, co-leading a small team of developers only with Web development experience.
- After only seven months developing iOS apps, given the responsibility of accompanying other developers first foray into iOS, alongside the development of new projects.
- A two week participation in the implementation of an iPhone and iPad application for one of the road authorities in Portugal Mobile access to traffic conditions and reporting of events (like traffic jams or road blocks) to the road authority systems, based on GPS positioning. Based on SOAP Web services.
- A month long project developing an iPad application for one of the major telecommunication companies in Portugal Access to 3G data plans traffic usage information.
- A two month project working in a team creating a set of animated, localizable children books for iPad, depicting biographies of major music composers. User interaction with both animated images and video. Most book customization can be made by tech-savvy, non-coder, content creator.
- A month long project working with a top Portuguese broadcasting network. Adapting a previous project to first iPad app in Portugal for sports publication;
- A two month project creating an eBook app framework based on XHTML+CSS for a top Portuguese broadcasting network used in (at least) a book about the football season in Portugal, completed with pictures (on device), and video feeds.
